2011 Annual Town Meeting Warrant**

TO: Amy Ouellette, a resident in the Town of St. Agatha, County and State aforementioned.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of St. Agatha, in said County, qualified by law to vote in said town affairs to meet at the St. Agatha Town Office, in said town on Tuesday the 8th day of June A.D. 2010 at 10:00 am in the morning, then and there to act on Article 1 & 2. The polls will open at 10:00 am and will close at 8:00 pm. **(The moderator will be elected 15 minutes prior to the opening of the polls)** And to notify and warn said voters to meet at the Knights of Columbus Hall in said town on Tuesday the 15th day of June A.D. 2010 at 7:00 pm, then and there to act on the remaining articles being set out below to wit:

- Article 1 To choose a moderator to preside at the meeting.
- Article 2 To elect all necessary Town Officers as is required to be elected by secret ballot (MRSA Title 30-A, § 2528). (1 School Board Member for a 3 year term - currently held by Sandra San Antonio and 1 Board of Selectmen Member for a 3 year term - currently held by Beurmond Banville)
- Article 3 To see if the Town will authorize the Board of Selectmen to appoint all necessary town officials not elected by secret ballot for the ensuing year.
- Article 4 To elect in open meeting those officials not required to be elected by secret ballot. Budget Committee - to choose four (4) members of the budget committee each for a term of three years. (Currently held by the following individuals: Fernande Desjardin; Keith Labrie; Mary Michaud; & Ned Berce).
- Article 5 To see what sum of money if any the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the **General Government Department.**

Article 18 To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to transfer from excise tax revenues, revenue sharing, homestead exemption reimbursement, fitness center revenue, recreation department revenue, community development department revenue and any other revenues received by the Town of St. Agatha, to set the 2011 Overlay, if needed, and for the purpose of reducing and setting the 2011 net property tax commitment and to allow the Board of Selectmen to accept gifts or donations on behalf of the Town for various accounts.

RECOMMENDED BY BOARD OF SELECTMEN

Article 19 To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to transfer the snowmobile registration refund from the Department of Inland Fisheries & Wildlife to the Red Arrow Snowmobile Club for the purpose of maintaining the local snowmobile trails.

RECOMMENDED BY BOARD OF SELECTMEN

Article 20 To see if the Town will vote taxes that the first half taxes shall be due and payable on or before October 31, 2010 and that the second half taxes be due and payable on or before April 30, 2011.

RECOMMENDED BY BOARD OF SELECTMEN

Article 21 To see if the Town will vote to set the interest at 7% per annum on any unpaid taxes for the first half on November 1, 2010 and on any unpaid taxes for the second half on May 1, 2011 to the date of payment.

RECOMMENDED BY BOARD OF SELECTMEN

Article 22 To see if the Town will authorize the Treasurer, under the direction of the Board of Selectmen, to sell and dispose of any real estate acquired by the Town for non-payment of taxes on such terms as they deem advisable and in the best interest of the Town and to sign and execute municipal quit claim deeds on such property.

RECOMMENDED BY BOARD OF SELECTMEN

Article 23 To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to sell and dispose of surplus town owned personal property on such terms and conditions as they deem advisable.

RECOMMENDED BY BOARD OF SELECTMEN

Article 24 To see if the Town will vote to increase the property tax levy limit of **\$463,088** established for the Town of St. Agatha by State Law in the event that the municipal budget approved by the preceding articles will result in a tax commitment that is greater than the property tax levy limit. (It is required that this article be voted by the written balloting process).

RECOMMENDED BY BOARD OF SELECTMEN


Article 25 To see if the Town will vote to accept tax payments prior to the commitment date and to pay interest on said tax payments in the amount of 0%.




